Contributors

Louis Bourne expanded his dissertation at New York University as *Fuerza invisible: lo divino en la poesía de Rubén Darío.* He has published poetry in Spanish and translations from Spanish to English, as well as articles on contemporary Spanish and Latin American authors and on post-Civil War Spanish poetry.

Julia Centurión Morton is a visiting professor of Spanish at Randolph-Macon College. Her current research interest is Andean literature, particularly in the area of the Peruvian city of Huancayo; she is in the process of compiling an anthology of Huancayo writers and producing a series of interviews with selected writers.

Michaela Voss Cottle is an assistant professor of French at Brigham Young University. Her areas of interest include Albert Camus, women authors, and personal writings such as notebooks, journals, and autobiographies.

Santiago García-Castañón, an associate professor of Spanish at Georgia College and State University, is a poet and an expert on the Spanish Golden Age. Among his books are *Diccionario de epónimos del español* (2001) and his most recent one, a critical edition of the previously unpublished *Verdadera relación de la grandeza del reino de China* (1575).

Javier Hernández Ruiz is a professor of the history of art in the School of Architecture and Fine Arts at the European University in Madrid. His work focuses on the history of Spanish cinema, the relationship between film and literature, and the relationship between film and architecture and the visual arts.

His areas of specialization are nineteenth- and twentieth-century Spanish literature; he has published on Larra, the romantics, *costumbrismo*, and the nineteenth century theater. Marina Nielsen is a lecturer and associate director of the Department of French and Classics at the Åbo Akademi University in Finland. She is currently on leave from that position, with a grant from the university foundation's Research Institute, preparing a monograph on French semantics.

John J. Stevens is an assistant professor of Spanish at the University of North Carolina at Wilmington. His research interests include Spanish dialectology, the acquisition of Spanish as a second language, and technology-enhanced language learning; he is currently studying sociolinguistic variation in the pronunciation of the Spanish grapheme <x>.
